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Introduction

Original records of the Lighthorne baptisms/christenings, marriages and burials exist from 1538 onwards and are stored at the Warwick County Record Office (WCRO), in 6 volumes, with reference numbers DR0018/1 to DR0018/6. Microfilm copies are available for consultation, as are scans on various websites. My transcriptions are of the scans seen on ancestry.co.uk. Permission to publish my transcriptions has been obtained from the Warwick County Record Office and is gratefully acknowledged.

Volume 2 (DR0018/2) entries comprise:
burials 1678 - 1735,
baptisms 1715 - 1735,
marriages 1715 - 1733

Entries of burials between 1678 and 1715 appear in volume 1 (DR0018/1) and are repeated, usually with the comment *in woollen* added, in this second volume (DR0018/2). However there are a few burials recorded in the second register only and not in the first. The burials which are recorded in the second register only are included in the first register in a transcriber's note.

Conventions used in the transcriptions

The pages of the register are un-numbered and the numbering of them is mine. I have not viewed the cover and I have given the cover verso page number 1. The entries start on page 2. Page content reflects that of the original register, though arrangement and line length does not. Dubious transcriptions are indicated with square brackets and a question mark. Illegible words are indicated by dots in square brackets. Words which have been abbreviated in the manuscript have been extended, with the inserted letters in italics, as in 'Thomas'. Words or passages in the register which appear to be a later insertion are indicated between pointed brackets. Transcriber's notes appear in blue, within square brackets.

The Julian and Gregorian calendars explained

The Julian calendar was in use in England until 1752 with the year ending on 24th March and the new year starting on 25th March. The Gregorian calendar, with the year ending on 31st December, was introduced in Europe in 1582, but was not officially used in England until 1752, in which year 2nd September was followed by 14th September in order to accommodate the change. However some vicars used the Gregorian calendar before 1752 and thus it is necessary to know which calendar is being used for dates recorded between 1st January and 24th March. Where it is obvious which calendar is being used, by the sequential nature of the entries, the date is recorded thus: 23 January 1728 [1729], meaning that 1728 is the date recorded in the register, but in today's Gregorian calendar we would know it as 1729. Where the choice of calendar is uncertain a question mark is used.

Summary of contents of Lighthorne register, volume 2 (1678 - 1735) DR0018/2

The scans on Ancestry for volume 2 are divided into 2 sections: 1675 - 1724 and 1715 - 1781. The column on the right gives the Ancestry page number which equates with the transcription page number.
