Agreed then by ye Minister & Church Wardens of ye Parish of Lighthorne & all other persons concerned at a general Meeting of ye said parish, (the consent of ye Lord Willoughby de Broke – being first obtained)

That Mr. Lydiatt ye present Rector that he is [MS creased] to erect a new Pew on ye North Side of ye Church in ye room of ye two seats next to ye Chancel one of which has usually went under ye Name of ye Cotton Seat and ye other formerly belonging to D'Orsheas and Highhorns Houses but now in ye possession of William Jeacocks, Thomas Mason, Richard Hunt, Widow D'Orshea & Joseph Rencher, who have places given them by ye said Mr. Lydiatt [....] in Exchange for their five places in aforesaid seat.
